Earlier childhood is the base on which fully accomplished citizens are built. Survival, growth, development and learning skills of a child depends on the quality of services offered during early childhood. Good quality of services integrate under a global unit, several aspects such as health, nutrition, hygiene, cognitive skills, and social, physical and affective development. The Early childhood center Paul Gérin-Lajoie opted for this holistic approach in its educational project in order to offer the best chances of success for the children.

Vision, mission, values

The **vision** of the Group of Reflection and Action for a New Haiti (GRAHN), the initiator of this Center, is based on a renewed education, which would transform every child of the country as a citizen proud of himself, benevolent towards his fellow citizens, concerned about the progress of the nation and predisposed to improve society as a whole. The Center for Early childhood Paul Gérin-Lajoie of Génipailler inherits this vision, and will serve as the engine for entering in the educational system.

The **mission** of this Center is to promote health, well-being, development and social integration of children aged 3 to 4 and their parents, providing them with a quality educational day care center on a voluntary basis and accessible to all.

The **values** of this center are those carried by GRAHN: The rule of law, respect for established rules, social justice, sharing, solidarity, education, respect for the environment and the worship of the common good.

Objectives

The main objective is to take charge, from early on in life, of children from rural areas to prepare them to become new enlightened, disciplined, creative, entrepreneurial, honest citizens, which the country needs to develop.

More specifically, the Early childhood center aims to:

- Offer quality educational day care services adapted to the needs of the families and the specific needs of the children aged 3 to 4;
- Prevent and reduce undesired effects that may arise from the precarity of their lives, thus allowing them to become fully integrated citizens able to implement positive social changes;
- Provide a sheltered living environment to children and families by focusing on the beneficial effects on their health, their well-being, their development, and social integration;
- Encourage children and families to use their full potential and contribute to offer them means and ways to become self-confident in order to achieve it.

Means helping a child from an underprivileged area of Haiti - in Génipailler, third communal section of Milot - to flourish, grow healthy, develop well, become a good citizen, get out of poverty through a quality education, and benefit from equal opportunities as the first step towards equality of outcomes in life.
